



Retail Guidelines for Fall/Winter Pop-Up

COVID19 Control Plan



The Upscale Weesale is an LLC Partnership Company registered in the State of South Carolina as a retail-based business.

The business has a federal tax ID # as well as a South Carolina Retail Sale & Use Tax certificate.

The Upscale WeeSale is a retail pop-up that serves the local community allowing families to buy and sell new & gently used items for their children. We hold these pop-up sales twice a year—once in Spring and once in Fall.



As we enter in to the various phases of re-opening South Carolina, The Upscale WeeSale will take great care in following all procedures and policies put in to place for the retail sector of the economy.

This will include social distancing guidelines, occupancy guidelines, cleaning/sanitizing procedures and more. Following is the Upscale WeeSale COVID19 Control plan for moving forward with our September sale dates.



SCHEDULED SHOPPING TIMES THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE SALES WEEK/END

So as to stay within the mandated maximum occupancy capacity as directed for retail establishments, we will create appointments for consumers to sign up for a specific time-frame to come shop with us. This will allow for browsing & shopping within the occupancy guidelines as outlined.

When a consumer registers for their ticket, they will be required to include their name, email and cell number. This allows for a database of those who shopped specific days/times in case this information is needed for Contact Tracing by the State DHEC.

Shoppers will arrive at the time of their ticket. They will have 1.5 hours to shop and then will be asked to check-out. If they want to check-out prior to the 1.5 hour timeline, they will be permitted to do so.

By having scheduled shopping times this will eliminate the lines to get in to the building as well as to give us the opportunity to better control the check-out procedure either eliminating or lessening the wait



SIGNAGE AT ENTRANCE

Signage will be posted at entrance for Access Screening. A staff member will be stationed at the entrance to ask each person to review the signage and self-report if any issues prior to entering.

ADDITIONAL PRECAUTIONS ON THE SALES FLOOR

One Way Signage will be placed at start of each aisle. Social distancing signage will be posted throughout the sale.

Staff will be placed throughout the floor to ensure that one-way signs and social distancing of at least 6-ft is being followed by shoppers.

We do not permit trying on of clothes, so this is not an issue for us.



CHECK OUT PROCEDURES

Check-out will be timed to correspond with the shopping appointment. All shoppers will be provided with maximum of 90 minutes to shop. At the 90 minute mark, they will be required to check-out. If they need to check out prior to their designated time, this will be permitted as long as there is not a line.

We will set up 10 - 12 registers for check out so that we can get 10-12 shoppers through the check out every 15 minutes. This will eliminate the usual check-out lines that build up during our sales.

Each register will have a shield/covering of plexiglass between the shopper and the cashier

All cashiers will wear a face mask/face covering

Each pay station will be wiped down between each transaction using a cleaning/disinfecting solution.

Contact-less payment will be encouraged, but we will have one register designated for cash transactions.



CHECK OUT PROCEDURES

Signage will be placed at the bathroom and at the sink indicating that these are hand washing stations and should be used by all consumers.



Additionally, hand sanitizer will be at each check out station for consumer use before they leave the building.

CLOSING PROCEDURES

At the end of each night, staff will wipe down all hard surfaces including door knobs, floors, tabletops, etc with a commercial-grade disinfectant/cleaner.



Goldshield is fully aligned and compliant with EPA's position re: COVID-19. All COVID-19 related changes to our normal sales process will be fully communicated to our consumers prior to the sale week/end. All will be notified of the need to wear a mask, use hand sanitizer, wash hands, check-out procedures PRIOR to arriving onsite.

We feel this is a solid safety plan that will mitigate issues that may arise throughout the week/end. We believe that the implementation of our policies and procedures will far exceed the policies & procedures that the governor and DOH has put in place for retail outlets.
